

DIRECTIONS
from LEONARDO DA VINCI AIRPORT (FIUMICINO)
to COLLEGIO PREZIOSISSIMO SANGUE
Via Narni, 29 · 00181 ROMA · tel : 06/ 78 46 98

The following instructions will get you from the airport to the train station near the Collegio. From there you must walk for about ten minutes to the Collegio. This involves walking uphill, and taxis may not be available at the station, especially for such a short trip. You could also take a taxi from the airport, which would cost about 50 euro, or you could take the train to the main train station (Stazione Termini) and a taxi from there. Instructions for this option are on the reverse side of this sheet.

1. Exit the passport control and baggage claim areas of the airport.
2. If necessary, stop at an ATM or currency *exchange* counter in the airport to withdraw or exchange money.
3. Follow the signs to the train station. (They are in Italian and English.)
4. Immediately before boarding the train, there is a *biglietteria*, or ticket booth, as well as ticket machines. Purchase a ticket for *Stazione Tuscolana*. The cost of the ticket is between €7,00 and €10,00.
5. **Validate the ticket** in the orange validating machine before boarding the train.
6. There are 3 tracks. You want a train that stops at all local stations. There are signs posted above each track telling the time of departure and the destination. The final destination for the train you want will be Fara Sabina, Orte, or Tiburtina. Be sure that the train makes all stops. (Do not take the express train to Termini since it makes no intermediate stops and it costs more!)
7. Board train with your validated ticket.
8. Enjoy your ride through some farmland and into the city – about 30 minutes. Once the conductor appears, give your ticket to him for further validation on the train. (Sometimes the conductor will not check tickets.)
9. Exit at *Stazione Tuscolana*. (It is the stop after *Ostiense*.) Walk down the stairs from the platform to the passage under the tracks.
10. You may either try to get a taxi or you may walk to Via Narni. It is about a ten minute walk, but the last two blocks are uphill. While you are still in the underground passage, you must make a choice:
 - *To walk* to Via Narni, take the exit to *Via Tuscolana*. At the end of the passage take the stairs to the right and then walk down a curved ramp – you are now on Via Tuscolana. Turn left on V. Tuscolana and walk to the second street, Via Amelia, and turn left again. The gate to the Collegio is at the end of Via Amelia at Via Narni, 29. (V. Amelia ends at V. Narni.)
 - *To get a taxi*, you will need to go in the direction of the *biglietteria*. Note that taxis may *not* be available there.

DIRECTIONS TO STAZIONE TERMINI WITH TAXI OPTION

1. Exit the passport control and baggage claim areas of the airport.
2. If necessary, stop at an ATM or currency *exchange* counter in the airport to withdraw or exchange money.
3. Follow the signs to the train station. (They are in Italian and English.)
4. Immediately before boarding the train, there is a *biglietteria*, or ticket booth, as well as ticket machines. Purchase a ticket for *Stazione Termini*. The cost of the ticket is about €10,00.
5. **Validate the ticket** in the orange validating machine before boarding the train.
6. There are 3 tracks. You want a train that goes to *Stazione Termini*. There are signs posted above each track telling the time of departure and the destination. The train to Termini is an express train that makes no intermediate stops. Board the train with your validated ticket.
7. When the conductor appears, give your ticket to him for further validation on the train. (Sometimes the conductor will not check tickets.)
8. When you arrive at Termini, exit the train and proceed to the taxi area in front of the station.
9. There might be a line for the taxis. Do not accept the offer of someone in the station for a taxi. The licensed taxis are white and will be lined up in front of the station and will use the meter. Expect to pay 10 – 20 euro for the trip to Via Narni
