### Small group discussion guide

After we have had time to read the Bevan's article, *Six Elements of Mission in Contemporary Missiology*; and to read and reflect on the discussion document from the CPPS Mission Workshop, we will gather in small groups for discussion. In the small group, ask someone to be the facilitator and reporter. Then discuss the following questions:

1. In what ways do you recognize/claim a personal missionary identity? What does being missionary mean to you?
2. Of the six elements found in the CPPS Theology of Mission- Which of them do you think that you have been able to best integrate into your own missionary identity? Why?
3. Of the six elements- Which of them do you think might represent a "growing edge" or a challenging perspective for you? Why?
4. Are there aspects or elements in the CPPS Theology of Mission document that you would like to see changed or omitted? Is there something that you think is missing and needs to be added?

Prepare a **brief** report for the group:

- An overview of your discussion
  - What did you find most valuable about the discussion?
  - Did the discussion help you to reflect on your own missionary identity?
- Your thoughts about the value of doing a similar process in your formation program.
  - Are there ways that you might modify the process that we followed to make it more suitable in the context of your formation program?
